



Jubilee Park and Community Center Summer Camp Art Teacher

Jubilee Park and Community Center is seeking for enthusiastic, energetic, and qualified Summer Camp Art Teacher. The Summer Camp Art Teacher is responsible for planning, organizing, and implementing Jubilee's Summer Camp Art Program and Visiting Artist Program. The Art Teacher will develop and implement art projects that foster an environment that is fun and creative for the campers as well as aid in organizing and assisting visiting artists in their art project implementation. The Summer Camp Art Teacher must be available to work June 3 to July 26, Monday–Thursday from 8:30am–2:00pm (subject to change) and will work with the Education Coordinator and Site Coordinators to ensure a positive delivery of program. The Summer Camp Art Teacher reports to the Director of Out-of-School-Time Programs.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Plan, prepare, and deliver engaging, age-appropriate, art activities that inspire K-12 students' creative processes and self-expression.
- Maintain an environment conducive to learning where students feel safe.
- Be able to problem solve and adapt to the needs of students, modifying instruction as needed.
- Inspire creative thinking through art examples and technique demonstration.
- Plan, prepare, and lead Jubilee's end of summer Gallery Walk, showcasing students' work and art pieces.
- The position requires a high aptitude to manage day-to-day interactions with children in grades K-12, a strong ability to work collaboratively with summer camp teachers, the summer camp team, and the capacity to be flexible.
- Follow and enforce Jubilee's Code of Conduct during camp hours.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of students' progress and development.
- Moderate standing, bending, and lifting.
- Attend staff meetings and trainings as required by the Director of OST Programs.

Qualifications

- Ability to instruct and manage students effectively and work well with children.
- Ability to communicate efficiently.
- Ability to prepare engaging and purposely nurturing quality lessons.
- 2+ years working in a classroom or afterschool setting.
- Certified teacher (preferred).
- Bilingual (English and Spanish preferred).
